The remainder is via traditional competitive tendering on a job-by-job basis. A system was wanted that could not only cope with this range of work, but would also integrate the cost accounts (by job) with the financial accounts and provide a broader picture of all the financial transactions.

A schedule of standard rates is used for costing and pricing the maintenance, repair and smaller construction jobs. Whilst, for larger projects, estimates are created via conventional techniques with details then entered into Job Costing. Standard templates are used as the basis for new jobs and typical costs collected are labour, materials, plant, disposal and subcontractors. "Tracing all the job costs at the time of billing is now a simple task, we no longer have to spend hours trawling through supplier invoices and timesheets" said Alex "and we are therefore much more confident of the profitability of each piece of work."

The company has over six hundred active jobs at any given time so getting to grips quickly with the new system was important. Alex comments, "We found that other programs we evaluated were very complex to use, but Exordia was user friendly and intuitively easy for our staff to get up to speed with. We have a six-user system and, overall, we are very pleased with the benefits we are getting from the program."
